

2022 Copper Hills History Day Project

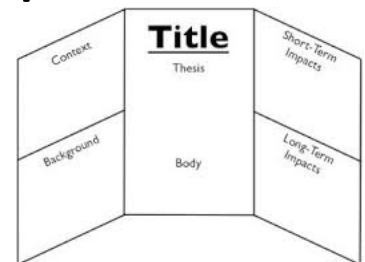
Theme Narrative: History: Successes, Failures, Consequences

History Day is a highly regarded academic competition for students from grades 4th-6th. Through participation in History Day, students learn critical thinking, problem-solving, research, reading, oral communication, written communication, and presentation skills. History Day shows students that history is not just about the names and dates of people and events from 200 years ago, but about the stories that happen every day in communities around the world.
