

# COPPER HILLS GROUP ORAL INTERPRETATION

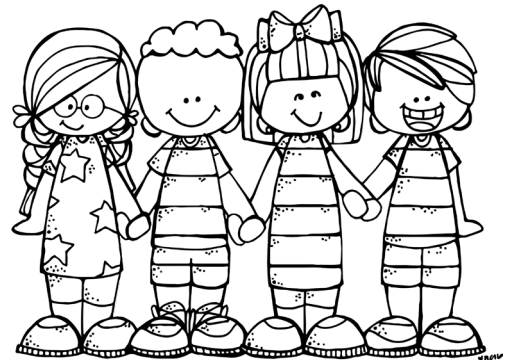
